From his obituary - Jim joined the Royal Canadian Artillery where he served on an Antiaircraft Gun from 1941 to 1946 in Halifax, Goose Bay, Holland and Northwest Germany. From 1946 until 1948, Jim fought in Palestine as a member of the Palestine Police Force. In 1948, he joined the Malayan Police Force where he fought until 1951. Jim rejoined the Canadian Army as a Military Policeman and served with the Occupational Force in Korea in 1954. He was stationed Halifax, from 1955-1961. From 1961-1964, he served with 4 CIBG in West Germany and returned to Halifax in 1964, where he worked until he was stationed to C.F.B. Cornwallis 1969-1972, when he retired after serving as Head of Security.
